

# Spanish Levels for Adults

## Overview

Each level aligns with ACTFL and CEFR proficiency standards, ensuring measurable, steady progress. Our adult learners build not only linguistic ability but also cultural confidence and the ability to communicate naturally in real-world settings.

### Level 1 – Principiante



ACTFL: Novice Low | CEFR: A1



Approx. Hours: 0–50 | Accumulated Years: 0–0.5

Build a strong foundation with essential vocabulary, greetings, and everyday phrases. Recognize and respond to simple questions and directions while developing confidence in basic communication.

### Level 2 – Comunicador



ACTFL: Novice Mid | CEFR: A1–A2



Approx. Hours: 50–100 | Accumulated Years: 0.5–1

Begin to engage in simple conversations and exchanges. Describe your daily life, preferences, and surroundings using short sentences and familiar expressions. Communicate basic needs and opinions with growing ease.

### Level 3 – Expresivo



ACTFL: Novice High / Intermediate Low | CEFR: A2



Approx. Hours: 100–150 | Accumulated Years: 1–2

Communicate with detail, personality, and confidence. Share opinions, describe experiences, and participate in guided discussions. Begin to use past and future tenses and connect ideas across sentences.



## Level 4 – Profesional



ACTFL: Intermediate Mid | CEFR: B1



Approx. Hours: 150–250 | Accumulated Years: 2–3

Apply Spanish effectively in professional, academic, and everyday settings. Narrate events, explain ideas, and maintain extended conversations. Develop strategies for accurate and fluent communication.

## Level 5 – Embajador



ACTFL: Intermediate High | CEFR: B2 |



Approx. Hours: 250–350 | Accumulated Years: 3–4.5

Demonstrate fluency and cultural competence. Engage naturally in debates, storytelling, and complex discussions. Adapt your language to different contexts and interact comfortably with native speakers.

## Level 6 – Avanzado



ACTFL: Advanced Low / Advanced Mid | CEFR: C1



Approx. Hours: 350+ | Accumulated Years: 4.5+

Achieve near-native fluency and refined communication. Express ideas with precision and depth, understand nuance, and use Spanish flexibly across social, professional, and academic environments.
