



Course Offerings for Adults – Fall II (Nov–Dec) 2025

The Chocolingua Spanish Program for Adults blends interactive lessons with grammar *in context*, storytelling, and cultural exploration. Each class focuses on real communication — not memorization — helping learners speak naturally while understanding how Spanish works.

Optional conversation sessions, such as Chocolate y Charla, give learners extra practice applying new grammar and vocabulary in authentic situations, from ordering coffee to sharing personal stories.



Spanish I- Principiante (Beginner)

Course Overview

Spanish 1 (Principiante) is an engaging beginner course for adults ready to start their Spanish journey in an interactive and meaningful way.

Through conversation-based lessons, you'll build a foundation in essential vocabulary, pronunciation, and grammar — all in context. Grammar is introduced naturally through stories, visuals, and dialogues, allowing learners to discover patterns and use them right away in conversation.

For example, while talking about daily routines, learners explore verbs like *ser*, *estar*, and *tener*; while describing people and places, they practice gender and number agreement — all through speaking, listening, and storytelling activities.

Every class connects language to culture, highlighting Hispanic/Latino customs, music, and everyday expressions. Learners are encouraged to join Chocolate y Charla, where they can apply new grammar and vocabulary in relaxed, real-world conversations.

Spanish 2 – Comunicador (Advanced Beginner)

Course Overview

Spanish 2 (Comunicador) is for learners who have completed Spanish 1 or already understand the basics. This course helps you connect sentences into conversation — moving from short responses to full, flowing exchanges.

You'll strengthen your grammar knowledge in use: reviewing present tense verbs, learning how to connect ideas with conjunctions, and exploring how to talk about the past (pretérito perfecto). Grammar appears through meaningful activities — not drills — like describing weekend experiences, expressing opinions, or comparing traditions.

Each class features dynamic interaction: guided dialogues, group tasks, storytelling, and cultural exploration. Learners also discover regional variations in vocabulary and expressions across the Spanish-speaking world.

Joining Chocolate y Charla allows you to reinforce grammar and fluency through casual, real-life conversation.

Chocolate y Charla – Beginner Conversation Lab

Course Overview

Chocolate y Charla (Chocolate & Chat) is the heart of real conversation practice. This optional session complements Spanish 1 and 2, helping learners use grammar and vocabulary in interactive, low-pressure settings. Each session feels like a friendly gathering — you'll talk, listen, laugh, and learn by doing.

Grammar comes alive through conversation: agreeing and disagreeing, using past and present tenses to tell stories, and practicing correct forms of *ser*, *estar*, *gustar*, and *tener* naturally while speaking.

Activities include cultural discussions, role plays, storytelling, games, and mini projects that reflect everyday communication — ordering food, sharing experiences, or describing traditions. Whether online or in person, you'll grow comfortable using Spanish spontaneously while deepening cultural appreciation.
