


Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: Can adults with previous Spanish experience join mid-program?

A: Yes. Learners are assessed and placed at the level that matches their current skills.

Q: How long does each level take?

A: Levels are designed for approximately 100–150 hours of practice. At 2 hours/week, most levels take 1–1.5 years. Increased weekly hours accelerate progress.

Q: What materials are required?

A: A notebook, pen, and willingness to participate. Any additional materials will be provided in advance by the instructor.

Q: Can I switch levels if I advance faster or need more support?

A: Yes. After assessments, learners can move up or revisit a level to ensure appropriate challenge and steady progress.

Q: Are classes in-person, online, or hybrid?

A: Learners can choose hybrid classes (attend in-person or online) or fully online classes.

Q: Are supplemental classes required, and how are they offered?

A: Supplemental classes, like Chocolate y Charla, Spanish for Travelers, Spanish Through Movies, Spanish Through Music, and Pronunciation & Accent Clinic, are optional but highly recommended. They are offered hybrid or fully online depending on the class.

Q: What if I miss a class?

A: We track hours per level. If you miss a session, you can make it up through online resources or supplemental practice. Returning after a break is easy—learners resume at the same level and continue progressing where they left off.

Q: Will I learn Spanish for professional or casual purposes?

A: Both! The curriculum balances real-life, social, and professional Spanish, so you can confidently use your skills in any context.

Q: How is progress tracked?

A: Learners receive updates on milestones, hours completed, and skills mastered, giving you a clear view of their measurable growth and next steps after each course.
